Hands4health is structured around a **systemic approach**. The intervention addresses contextualised gaps and their root causes, and includes an extensive research component in Switzerland and the countries. To investigate the intervention's overall effect, a health impact evaluation will be conducted through cluster randomised controlled trials.


